


Since 1965 the SHF has gathered, restored and preserved a collection of vessels of national and international significance, which together tell the story of Sydney's maritime history.



#### HAVE YOUR SAY ON BERRYS BAY

The community will soon be invited to shape the future of Berrys Bay to develop a vision for this historic and beautiful location, on the east of the Waverton peninsula.

Member for North Shore Felicity Wilson said forming the consultative group is part of the NSW Government's commitment to creating new public open space alongside the delivery of the future Western Harbour Tunnel and Beaches Link.

"We understand the importance of Berrys Bay to our local community, and this is an important step in preparing a concept layout for the area so it's finally an open and accessible asset for the public," Ms Wilson said.

"We will soon be asking representatives of the community to be a part of the Berrys Bay consultative group, along with key stakeholders and independent experts."

Berrys Bay will be temporarily used during construction of the Western Harbour Tunnel and returned to public facilities and open space when the project is complete.

Ms Wilson said previous ideas for Berrys Bay included a small community marina, open parks and boat mooring.

"We've heard some great ideas already around connecting existing parkland and open space, such as a continuous connection from Carradah Park through Berrys Bay to Balls Head, including the beach and old quarantine facilities," Ms Wilson said.

"It is important to respect the heritage and character of the area while also considering the possibility to attract place activation opportunities like cultural or food and beverage opportunities."

Transport for NSW is working with the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment to jointly establish the group.

The latest community update includes the release of the submissions report on the Western Harbour Tunnel and Warringah Freeway Upgrade's Environmental Impact Statement and plans to create a community consultative group. 




# CONCEPT ONLY Entry Level (Level 01)
