The final meeting of the Sydney Harbour HighLine (SHHL) Committee was held on 12 October 2018. At the conclusion of that meeting, the SHHL Association agreed to:

- coordinate with other members of the Committee and
- prepare a report on the findings of the Committee, including an application for funding of the project, for Mr Andrew Constance MP, Minister for Transport and Infrastructure.

After little assistance from other members of the Committee, the report was completed by the SHHL Association. On 12th December 2018 it was lodged on behalf of the Committee with the Minister for Transport and Infrastructure and the Premier with a request for an early response.

The Mosman Daily organised a photo shoot on the rail line with Minister Constance and SHHL Association representatives on 10 January 2019. We were hoping the Minister would announce at that time the Government funding for commencement of the HighLine.

Regrettably the photo shoot was postponed. We believe the postponement was due to the absence from Sydney of Howard Collins, Chief Executive Sydney Trains. We understand the photo shoot will be rescheduled for early February.

We delayed sending this Newsletter as we had hoped it would coincide with the long-awaited Government announcement to fund the HighLine. Regrettably we now have to wait a little longer.
